The University of Dar Es Salaam Business School (UDBS) announces three short courses geared towards improving Human Resource Capacity of various individuals and institutions in both the public and private sectors in Tanzania. PROJECT PLANNING MONITORING AND EVALUATION

9th_13th October, 2017: University of Dar es Salaam Business School (UDBS), Dar es salaam, Tanzania

Effective Monitoring and evaluation of projects is one of the major challenges facing project /program implementers. Most projects/programs fail to realize their intended objectives and end up having little or no impact due to inadequate follow up during and after their implementation.

COURSE OBJECTIVES

This course aims at developing and enriching monitoring and evaluation skills of project/program implementing and supervisory staff in government, NGOs, corporate organizations, parastatals, academic institutions etc. It is designed to impart skills for effectively formulating, implementing, monitoring and evaluating projects/programmes as well as being able to conduct project/programme impact assessment. The facilitation will be conducted by well-experienced experts and skilled trainers with the specific objectives of the course being:

To create an understanding of the meaning and importance of monitoring and evaluation at policy, programme, strategic plan and project levels; To enable participants effectively and efficiently undertake the different kinds of project/programme monitoring and evaluation processes and procedures; To enable participants plan, prepare and implement Monitoring and Evaluation schemes and execute and manage M+E and Impact Assessment activities; To enable participants prepare M & E reports and understand the utilization of monitoring and evaluation results.

WHO SHOULD ATTEND THE COURSE?

Senior and middle level officials in governmental and non-governmental institutions. NGOs, training institutions, government agencies, government departments, consulting firms, who are (or are expected to be) responsible for management/evaluation of projects or training in this area.

COURSE FEES

Course fees are TZS. **700,000**/= (Five hundred thousand Tanzanian shillings) per participant, excluding accommodation. The fees cover the cost of training material, lunch, light snacks and soft drinks in the course of training for **five days**. The course will start at 8.30am to 4.00pm. The application deadline is 30^{th} September, 2017.
